Q.3. What is the eligibility for BPA Program?

For the BPA (Contemporary Western Music) program, a candidate must have passed 10+2 or equivalent examination from any stream and must have obtained a minimum 50% aggregate

Q.4. What is the admission process for enrolment into BPA program?

Step 1: Apply for BPA Program @ www.sopa.nmims.edu and upload a video of the candidate's performance on YouTube (as a private video) and attach the link in the application form.

Step 2 : Final Audition - The candidates will then be shortlisted and called in for auditions on specific dates at the School

Step 3: Interview with the Dean

Admission offer is given as per merit list that is released by the School.

Q.5. What areas will be tested under the Final Audition?

Performance -The candidate can choose any song of your choice of the level that describes his/her best performing ability. He/she will be assessed on accuracy, technique and stylistic elements	50
Improvisation - The candidate will be given simple improvisation over pop song / ballad progression and asked to work it out for performance. Scatting for vocalist	25
Aural-Basic intervals and triad recognition. Identifying changes in rhythm, melody or pitch	25
Personal Interview- Question will be asked to assess the candidate's aptitude. This will be a non-technical round	50
